The wooden outdoor classroom in the Pre-Prep playground is a great place for reading and drawing, and the children love dressing up and performing to each other on the outdoor stage.

The woodland shelter and fire pit are hubs for stories, learning and activities. Children enjoy outdoor lessons and bug hunts are always popular! Gathering around the campfire for hot chocolate and toast is a firm favourite, especially when parents, grandparents and guardians come along.

Pre-Prep boasts unparalleled play facilities in the recently refurbished playground. A fleet of pedal cars can be raced around the racetrack; an orchestra of outdoor instruments provide great noise and climbing frames, balancing bars and a large open games area mean that there is something for everyone. We have our own Pre-Prep fruit and vegetable garden which is tended by the Gardening Club and also provides a home for our resident rabbits who are well loved and looked after by the children.

Sharing new ideas and teaching techniques are always popular topics in the staffroom. Small classes and a high staff to pupil ratio enables personalised learning at an individual pace. Our teachers will always go the extra mile to ensure that children get the very best out of their Pre-Prep education, equipping them to start the Prep full of confidence and enthusiasm.

We have wonderful facilities and a full range of activities for children to enjoy.

Our playground is a buzz of excitement at every breaktime. Music is an important part of school life, with our choir, bell choir, recorder and ukulele groups and opportunities for every child to learn an instrument. Our popular dance lessons include Ballet, Tap and Modern Dance. Children get to grips with nature in our outdoor classroom and love getting stuck into our many woodland projects. We start teaching French in Nursery, building a good foundation for the Prep syllabus.

Most weeks are 'themed'; we cover a range of interesting topics that embrace all areas of learning from Space to the Great Fire of London, Chinese New Year to the Seaside. After school there are lots of opportunities to enjoy new experiences and follow your passions. Gardening, art, clay, cookery, mindfulness, pilates, computing and logic are just some of the activities on offer. The children go on many trips during the year and visiting groups bring topics to life. Our school library is full of interesting books to share and enjoy.

Learning is inspired by fully engaging young minds, trying new things, thinking about the world around us and working together on enjoyable projects and themed workshops.

Life is full, and learning in some form or another is taking place in almost every aspect of school life.



Nursery year

Our Nursery Class takes children from 3 to 4 years old before they enter Pre-Prep. We have a wonderful Nursery team of very experienced staff including our Nursery Teacher and two NNEB Nursery Nurses. The core Nursery hours run from 8.45 am to 11.45 am with optional Busy Bees afternoon sessions, and we offer flexible wraparound care that allows children to stay from 7.30 am until 6.00 pm every day.

Nursery is a very caring environment in which children develop their social and learning skills. There's always lots to do with a fun packed curriculum including swimming, dance, art, gym, ballet, cooking, numeracy, literacy, French, music, woodland activities, fun play and learning. The children love being together and while it's always an action packed day, there's still time for a little snooze to recharge those batteries.

Children also become familiar with life in Reception, so that once their Nursery year is complete, they move seamlessly into the Reception class to carry on their learning adventure.
