# Art & design

A light, spacious and purpose built studio is home to our Art & Design Department. Art encourages children to experiment with lots of different media including sculpture, ceramics, modelling, screen printing, painting and drawing. The quality of work on display is often compared to GCSE portfolios.

Children are encouraged to explore the things that interest them. They are taught artistic skills to develop their abilities and learn about proportion, the use of colour, balance and perspective. From Year 6, children can join extra Art Club where they enjoy exploring new ideas and further developing their individual styles and interests.

Our Design and Technology Department is located in the same building as the Art Department. Children develop a range of skills across a variety of projects, as well as developing their own dexterity through traditional hand-crafts.

Designing the things you will then make becomes a passion for many children, working individually and as part of a team. One of our greatest team challenges has been the design and build of an eco-powered go-kart to enter, along with a driver, into the Greenpower Challenge at Goodwood race track.



## Flexible boarding

Boarding is an integral part of Twyford life. Rooms are comfortable and bright. There's a friendly family environment, and always plenty to do. Boarding is flexible, so whether it's a one or two night stopover, the occasional sleepover to attend a club, or weekly boarding we're happy to work around you. All our teachers help with a boarding evening. There's a strong sense of community. Friendships are made across all age groups and it's an opportunity for children to enjoy getting to know staff outside the busy school day.

Everyone looks out for each other and our core values of respect, honesty, kindness and responsibility are evident in every aspect of boarding life. # The great outdoors

Healthy body, healthy mind is a philosophy that hasn't changed over many decades at Twyford. Within our grounds we enjoy incredible adventure facilities and woodlands where children can explore the natural world.

Our woodland shelter is popular as an outdoor learning centre, the location for evening stories and a gathering point for woodland projects. Outdoor learning and adventure is an important part of a child's education; it helps develop an awareness of the world around them and understand the delicate relationship we have with nature.
